Journal entries are the first step in the accounting cycle and are used to record all business transactions and events in the accounting system. As business events occur throughout the accounting period, journal entries are recorded in the general journal.

An accounting journal, also called the book of first entry or general journal, is a record of business transactions and events for a specific account. A journal chronologically stores all the journal entries for a specific account in one place, so management can analyze the data.

### **Posting from a General Journal to a General Ledger**

The general ledger is where all accounting transactions are posted in a double entry system using debits (on the left) and credits (on the right) for each transaction. An additional column to the far right can keep a running total of activity in the account, similar to your checkbook. The debit and credit entries impact at least two ledger accounts and it is usual to capture enough information ...
